As we conclude this edition, I would like to remind us of our original scripture again:



John 16:32-33, Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me. These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

The Lord Jesus Christ reminded us that even when men would depart from Him, God would still be with Him. This is the confidence that we all should continually hold to our hearts. That the Lord God who begun with us will continually be with us and finish with us. May His peace govern our hearts in this confidence, even when we face tribulations, we can still be cheerful because He has overcome the troubles of this world. May your faith not be moved by any circumstance. May you remain in Him, rooted and grounded knowing that in Him we move and in Him we have our being.

Colossians 2:6-10, As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him: Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving. Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. For in him dwelleth all the fullness of the Godhead bodily. And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

Acts 17:38, For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring.

Let nothing separate us from His dear love. May we say like Apostle Paul, having tasted His love ask, check and declare, that nothing will separate us from His dear love. That we will remain in Him, trust in Him, Hope in Him and depend on Him fully as our everything. When storms rise

and hope fails, we will still hope in Him. That we will hide in Him as our rock of refuge and strong tower. And that our hearts will not be moved because we know He is the solid rock. Look at what Apostle Paul said in *Romans 8:31-39*.

What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? Who shall lay anything to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Let me conclude again with the words of Apostle Paul to His son Timothy. Paul felt left alone by the brethren, only Luke remained with Him. He therefore asked for Timothy to do his diligence and come to Him shortly. Paul goes further to point out that at some point no man stood with him; all men forsook him! But he quickly points out that during this time of physical loneliness, the Lord stood with him, and strengthened him! That is and shall forever be our portion too in Jesus name. When we feel forsaken and let down, the Lord will surely be with us. He says, the Lord was not only with him, but also delivered him from the mouth of the Lion. That God who was with Paul and delivered Him from the Lion is also the same one who delivered Daniel from Lions inside the den. This God also delivered Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego from the fiery fire of Nebuchadnezzar. He is the same yesterday; He is the same today and even forever. He will be with you and deliver you too.

2Timothy 4: 9-18, Do thy diligence to come shortly unto me: For Demas hath forsaken me, having loved this present world, and is departed unto Thessalonica; Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia. Only Luke is with me. Take

Mark, and bring him with thee: for he is profitable to me for the ministry. And Tychicus have I sent to Ephesus. The cloke that I left at Troas with Carpus, when thou comest, bring with thee, and the books, but especially the parchments. Alexander the coppersmith did me much evil: the Lord reward him according to his works: Of whom be thou ware also; for he hath greatly withstood our words. At my first answer no man stood with me, but all men forsook me: I pray God that it may not be laid to their charge.Notwithstanding the Lord stood with me, and strengthened me; that by me the preaching might be fully known, and that all the Gentiles might hear: and I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion. And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.



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TEACHING OF THE MONTH Road To Maturity (The Tongue) - Part 2



Jesus always spoke words full of grace, compassion and love. These words not only attracted and endeared people to Him but also made others not to believe his accusers. (Luke 4:22 'So all bore witness to Him, and marveled at the gracious words which proceeded out of His mouth. And they said, "Is this not

Joseph's son?") During Creation, God spoke and things were created. (Genesis 1:3-25) He also gave Adam the opportunity to name animals and whatever name he gave, so they became. Genesis 2:19-20 'Out of the ground the Lord God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name. So Adam gave names to all cattle, to the birds of the air, and to every beast of the field. But for Adam there was not found a helper comparable to him.'

Positive use of my tongue

James 3:1-12 talks about the tongue and how powerful a member it is. From it we learn that;

- Our tongue can be used for good and bless others.
- A tongue is a good member of the body. An instrument that controls the whole body or course of life.
- The tongue when used well, will usher you into your destiny. What you are today is an outcome of your tongue.

Further we learn that;

a) The tongue is powerful. If you conquer it, you are perfect.

James 3:2, 'For we all stumble in many things. If anyone does not stumble in word, he is a perfect man, able also to bridle the whole body.'

- Use your tongue to set the world on fire for Jesus Christ. *James 3:9.*
- Use your tongue to praise God. (*Psalm 35:28*, 'And my tongue shall speak of Your righteousness And of Your praise all the day long.')
- When you bless people with your tongue it means you are agreeing with God and also worshiping him.
- For all God created is good. He blessed man in *Genesis* 1:27-31.

b) The tongue when well used, will fill your store house and satisfy you.

(*Proverbs 18:20,* 'A man's stomach shall be satisfied from the fruit of his mouth; From the produce of his lips he shall be filled.')

- c) The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it eat its fruit. (*Proverbs 18:21*, 'Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.') And (*Proverbs 10:11*, 'The mouth of the righteous is a well of life, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked.')
- Use your tongue to give life. This means you have power to give life.
- With your tongue you can nourish one another. (*Proverbs* 10:20a, 'The tongue of the righteous is choice silver; 21 'the

lips of the righteous feed many, but fools die for lack of wisdom.')

- In *Genesis 31:32*, Jacob speaks words that destroy Rachel in *Genesis 35:16-19*. As soon as her son Benjamin is born, she dies

d) When used well the tongue brings hope, light and peace.

i.e. The right word at the right time to the right people or audience. (*Proverbs 10:31-32*, 'The mouth of the righteous brings forth wisdom,

But the perverse tongue will be cut out. The lips of the righteous know what is acceptable, But the mouth of the wicked what is perverse.')

e) The tongue will create for you your own world/realm.

- In *Gen 49:1-28*, the Children of Jacob became whatever Jacob declared.
- In *Mark 16:15-20*. The great commission is fulfilled through the tongue. Jesus gives the disciples the commission with a promise and as they go out in obedience, preaching everywhere, the Lord was working with them and confirming the word through accompanying signs.
- Jesus says in *Mark 11:23*, 'For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.' With your tongue you can change the landscape of life by moving mountains.

f) With your tongue you can affect the happenings in heaven.

- With our tongue we can change situations in the atmosphere. Jesus said in *Mathew 18:18*, "Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

g) You can use your tongue to speak mysteries unto God and edify self.

- As we speak in other tongues, glorifying the Father, we're edified. (I Corinthians 14:2-4, 'For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries. But he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men. He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church.')

Conclusion

Colossians 4:6, 'Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt so that you may know how to answer everyone.'

Titus 2:8, 'sound speech that cannot be condemned, that one who is an opponent may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of you.'

May we declare as David did in **Psalm 39:1**, 'I said, "I will guard my ways, Lest I sin with my tongue; I will restrain my mouth with a muzzle, While the wicked are before me."

FINANCIAL BREAKTHROUGH – Part 1

Financial Prudence & Breakthrough

Financial Management means refers to the efficient and effective management of money (funds) in such a manner as to accomplish the desired goals or, aims or objectives of the organization. It involves planning, controlling and pulling together of resources and effective utilization of the same, towards achieving your goals or objectives.

Obedience is the Key to success.

As believers God has given us biblical principles that relate to our material well-being. We can at least overcome areas within our sphere of responsibility.

Applying God's principles may not bring all we desire but it can eliminate avoidable and needless distress.

A. Seek God first

On the highest level we're requested to seek God first and all things shall be added unto us. Have a relationship with God.

Matthew 6:33, "Seek first his kingdom and his righteousness and all these things will be given to you as well."

B. Pay Tithe

Malachi 3: 8-12, 'Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings. Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation. Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts. 12 And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delight some land, saith the LORD of hosts.

THINGS TO NOTE

God's way of providing material necessities. It is through giving. A tithe (ten percent) of one's income

- a) We rob God by failing to pay tithes and offerings.
- To Him disobedience to his biblical financial principles is robbery.
- We rob God of what belongs to him. He said, "Will a man rob God? Yet you rob me...in tithes and offerings. You are under a curse – the whole nation of you because you are robbing me"
- · God allows a financial curse or wilderness to develop in our lives.

- The curse of not to pay tithes and offerings results in scarcity and continual harassment from the devourer (devil) either through a financial misfortune, losses, theft, and money going to cover for sickness, and other unnecessary burdens.
- A whole nation or household can be under a curse because of one of the heads of a family is walking in disobedience.
- Wilderness experience is a sign that there is something God requires of us that we're not fulfilling.
- The wilderness that we can live to regret for having gone through is the self-made one. It comes as a result of disobedience to God. In the self-made one there is everything we can do to get out of it. Here we have the power of choice but we choose to ignore God's principles.
- · In the God-made wilderness there is nothing we can do except enduring it.
- Our God-made financial wilderness is mostly during the years of our upbringing. We receive manna we never worked for. The manna is just enough to get by and scarce enough to continue looking forward to our own means.
- And because God is merciful He gives manna to the disobedient so that they survive one day at a time.

Are we surviving on Manna or we have entered Canaan?

God fed the Israelites manna during their 40 years in the wilderness. Manna was enough for the day and could not be stored for the next day. Any attempt remains for the following day failed, except the day immediately preceding the Sabbath. Attempts to preserve met to the manner going bad. After 40 years the disobedient generation was wipe out except Joshua and Caleb, who had obeyed God.

Then God asked Joshua to circumcise the sons of the disobedient generation. After Joshua obeyed and observed the Passover God opened the doors for Israelites to eat of their own produce in Canaan.

The manna stopped (*Joshua 5*) and the Israelites were no longer bound to daily rations.

Their reproach, which was a sign of bondage, was rolled away when the new generation matured and it fulfilled its obedience through Joshua. "Today I have rolled away the reproach of Egypt from you," Joshua 5:9.

Until obedience is fulfilled the manna continues.

b) How do we attract a Financial Curse?

Jeremiah 17:5, 'Thus says the LORD," Cursedis the man who trusts in mankind And makes flesh his strength, And whose heart turns a way from the LORD.

Psalm 118:8-9, 'It is <u>better</u> to <u>trust</u> in the <u>LORD</u> than to put <u>confidence</u> in <u>man</u>. It is <u>better</u> to <u>trust</u> in the <u>LORD</u> than to put <u>confidence</u> in <u>princes</u>.'

Disobedience will keep us in Canaan; it does not matter

how long it takes God will be waiting for us to take the fast step toward obeying His word. For a day with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day."

2 Peter 3:8, "But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day." "The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance."

- c) There is no food in the store house. There can be no development even in the house of God. No evangelism, missions etc.
- d) God will open the Floodgates of Heaven.
- · God challenge to prove Him, He will open the windows of heaven, pour out a blessing and there will be no room to receive the blessings
- Through the tithes and offerings, God says he is moved to "throw open the floodgates of heaven" to bless the giver. It may not be instant or come in a way the giver may assume. However God works everything out in his way and timing to bless the giver.

Isaiah 55:8-9, "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," says the LORD. "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts.

- In the case of financial or material breakthrough, God personally opens the windows of heaven to bless us. This happens as we apply the principles of seed time and harvest time. We do not need to pray or ask him to open the windows of heaven.
- Can you imagine God asking us to challenge, test or tempt him? He says, "Test me in this and see if I will not open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessings that you will not have room enough for it" (Malachi 3:10).
- There is so much in heaven that God had to build floodgates - Actually. Floodgates are for stopping floods. God's kingdom is flooded with blessings waiting to be poured out to obedient persons in the

- biblical financial principles.
- He says "test me," "try me," or "go on, dare me!!" In paraphrasing he is saying "let's see who is going to outdo the other in the giving between you and I."
- · "Let's see if what you give to me will be more than what I give back in return to you." It's easy to know who the winner will be.
- Seeing the faithfulness of God fulfilled in our lives, our children's gives us more reasons for believing in Him.

e) Rebuke the devour on our behalf. There will be no loss, miscarriage

Not only does He open doors for his blessings he also prevents the enemy from undoing our blessings. You probably know people who received much only to loose it all in mysterious ways, to suffer crippling health problems or other misfortune. scarcity, losses, theft, and other unnecessary burdens.

And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.

HE is going to turn back or keep down the devil, our enemy (the devourer). It also means that God is going to keep the enemy in check!!!

God is going to be watching over us to make sure that the devil does NOT devour (destroy, harm, or cause any problems) in our lives or with anything that belongs to us!!!

God works to prevent such experiences for as long as we continue obeying his word.

f) Will be called blessed and a sight to behold in the land.

Jeremiah 17:7-8, 'Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is. For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.
